### Psalm Notes

The *Scottish Psalter* (1595) was unique in that it contained a series of prayers based on the Psalms. These prayers breathe the spirit of humble confidence in God in the midst of trouble and persecution. Here is the prayer for Psalm 27 from that psalter:

“Father of light and fountain of all goodness, be helpful unto us in time of our affliction: and when we are in greatest danger, hide not Thy face from us; yea, whatsoever thing fall unto us, strengthen our hearts, that we may have a continual hope of all the good things, which Thou has promised to us, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.”

### How to Become a Member

Christ’s Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20) is fulfilled in Christians who commit themselves to Christ and to one another in covenant relationship.
