### Psalm Notes

“Light” and “salvation” are God’s answer to our sense of darkness and danger. Along with His “strength” these provide the antidote to our great fears. God’s nearness has always been the true and abiding comfort of His people.

The psalm goes on to illustrate how the experience of worship solidifies and intensifies our comforts. Worship with the people of God is a precious privilege that ought not to be lightly forsaken. David’s words become increasingly bold as he goes through the remainder of the psalm. He ends with the exhortation to the singer or reader of this psalm:

“Wait for the LORD; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the LORD!”

**Singing** the psalms keeps before us the unity of the Bible and the oneness of the people of God. We **sing** this sweet song of God’s protection and peace **because its promises are ours in Christ**. We **sing** the Psalms because we cannot do better in praise or prayer than the words God Himself has given us in the Psalms.

### How to Become a Member

Christ’s Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20) is fulfilled in Christians who commit themselves to Christ and to one another in covenant relationship. Through **church membership** we acknowledge that Jesus Christ alone is the Head and Lord of the Church and we commit ourselves to do our part to build up the body of Christ for mission.
