### Psalm Notes

The word "alone" in **Psalm 62:1** is an important word. If one's hope is in God *alone*, then such hope is sure and steadfast—not because of the strength of our faith but because of the faithfulness of the One in whom we trust. All other hopes are false hopes and will disappoint.

The familiar words, "I shall not be moved" (verse 2) are rendered in the psalter version as "unshaken I'll remain." This steadfastness is the result of the care and support of our covenant-keeping God. The strength that is needed for each trial is abundantly and effectively supplied.

The psalms are the songs of the church in her militancy—that is, amidst the strife and opposition of her enemies and in her battles against the world, the flesh and the devil. They are songs of courage and confidence.

**Singing** the psalms keeps before us the unity of the Bible and the oneness of the people of God. We **sing** this sweet song of God's protection and peace **because its promises are ours in Christ**. We **sing** the Psalms because we cannot do better in praise or prayer than the words God Himself has given us in the psalms.
