Notice of a Congregational Meeting

There will be a congregational meeting of the members of Redeemer Presbyterian Church on Sunday, November 28 at 9:15AM for the purpose of electing one additional deacon. The session is nominating James Ferebee for this office. If elected, ordination and installation will follow in the worship service that day. A quorum for the congregational meeting consists of one-fourth of the total membership of our church.

Get to Know James Ferebee:

James Cooper Ferebee was born in Cumberland Furnace and—except for a brief time living in Gallatin, Tennessee—grew up in Dickson County.

He graduated from Dickson High School and, at the age of eighteen, began his career with the Dupont Corporation in New Johnsonville, Tennessee. He served in many positions while at Dupont including: Safety and Health Supervisor, Manager of Plant Resources, and Team Manager in Production. He retired in 2001 with over forty years of service. He then worked as a consultant in Safety and Health for two corporations until 2009.

Jim retired the second time in order to care for his wife of fifty years until her death in 2011.

Jim has three children, six grandsons, one great-granddaughter, and another due in March.

He grew up in the Methodist Church in Cumberland Furnace and made his profession of faith at the age of fourteen. He was a member of First Baptist Church in Dickson prior to uniting with Redeemer.

Jim and Ann married in 2020.

Jim Ferebee is nominated for election and ordination as a deacon in our church. The congregational meeting is scheduled for November 28 at 9:15AM.
